The CarePoint Access Module detects signals from your residents' help devices and passes them to the Central Monitoring Station for dispatch to staff members.

Depending on the coverage needs of your community, a customized network will be designed to ensure residents are able to signal for help from designated areas of your campus. The Wireless Receiver works with SmartCare Software offering a locating feature which provides staff members with a zone based location to enable quick response to alarms.

The 7000R is certified for UL2560 installations when used with the 7000 family of personal help buttons and fall detection devices. The 7000R is compatible with all Philips Lifeline alert and monitoring devices including:
